Easily Access Everything on the Conference App

If you haven't already, I encourage you to download the Conference App. We will use an online platform called Whova for our event. Download the app from the App Store using your mobile device by scanning the QR Code. 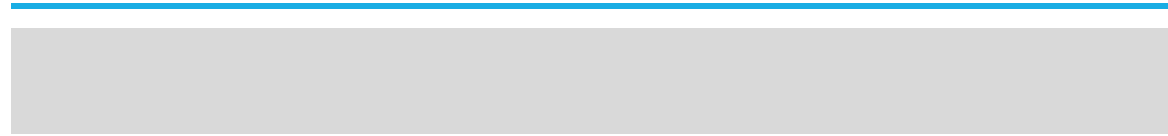
